

**Motion to support the recommendations presented in the Canadian Association of Research Libraries- Association des bibliothèques de recherche du Canada (CARL-ARBC) Submission to the Consultation on Options for Reform of the Copyright Board of Canada.**

Be it resolved that Council of Atlantic University Libraries / Conseil des bibliothèques universitaires de l'Atlantique supports the following recommendations presented in the Canadian Association of Research Libraries- Association des bibliothèques de recherche du Canada (CARL-ARBC) Submission to the Consultation on Options for Reform of the Copyright Board of Canada:

1. The Board should encourage and support engagement by non-commercial and public interest stakeholders by offsetting expenses related to such interventions.
2. Tariffs should only apply prospectively, or measures should be put in place to limit the length of time affected by retroactivity.
3. All documents filed with the Board and matters relating to them should be made publicly available whenever possible.
4. Procedural improvements to the Board should be undertaken through regulation whenever possible.
